At the NSF EHR Advisory Committee meeting on May 6, 2013, it was officially announced that the popular TUES (Transforming Undergraduate Education in STEM) will be eliminated. A new EHR program, CAUSE (Catalyzing Advances in Undergraduate Science Education), has been created that should provide many of the same education and training opportunities in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) as the former TUES.
